Methods of Restoring Devices to Factory Settings

LED Method 1 - App Operation:

When light blinks 3 times - restore successfull

Method 2 - Manual Operation:

Make sure LED powers are on for 15 seconds, then turn power off for 5 seconds
 Repeat step one 4 times in a row, when light blinks 3 times - restore successfull

Remote Control

Adding to Mesh Network:

- 1) Hold group keys 1 and 2 longer than 2 seconds till LED lights will flash in red it means system is ready for configuration
- 2) Add Remote Control using the Bluelight software in smartphone (process is the same as adding luminaires) - Remote Control icon will appear on the page after adding. After icon is added, press any key on Remote Control to exit configuration page.

Exiting Mesh Network (equal to factory reset):

The reset key on the back of the panel will be used to exit network (open the battery cover). Hold the button for more than 2 seconds - you will see red and blue indicators flashing, it means you are totally out of network.

Note: Remote Control will quit setting mode if there are any mistakes during the process, in that case you should restart.

Control Panel

Entering network:

- 1) Open the APP into the corresponding to scene configuration page, click the add button.
- 2) Holding the group key 1 and 2 for more than 2 seconds will make blue indicator lights flash it means that the system is waiting for configuring and entering the network.
- 3) Install remote control panel software to your smartphone the process is same as adding the luminaries. The remote control panel icon will be shown on the page after succesfull adding. Press any key on remote control panel, exit the configuration page - entering network is complete.

Exiting network (recovering factory settings):

The reset key on the back of the panel will be used to exit network (open the battery cover). Hold the button for more than 2 seconds - you will see red and blue indicators flashing, it means you are totally out of network.

Note: Control Panel will quit setting mode if there are any mistakes during the process, in that case you should restart.
